ACCESS

Animation students wishing to access the FA316/307 stop motion labs, must first gain GENERAL ACCESS.
Students with General Access, may work any time **MON-FRI 8AM-9PM** if they fit within PRIORITY ACCESS

GENERAL ACCESS

-current enrollment in any *one* of these courses: 3780 Art&Motion
3810 Experimental Animation
4921 Capstone Animation
-inclusion on access list by animation faculty and security, held in the Art Office.

PRIORITY ACCESS

(#1) students using the facilities during their scheduled class time
(#2) Capstone students
(#3) 3810 and 3780 students

CLARIFICATION

-If the room(s) have an animation class scheduled at the time*, students in that current class have #1 priority to facilities during the hours of the class. But if there is any unused space or equipment, a Capstone Student has highest priority for accessing it, followed by 3810 or 3780 students. If needs change within current class hours, students enrolled in that class have continued highest priority.

-If the room(s) have no classes scheduled at the time, (OPEN LAB time) Capstone students have highest priority, followed by 3810 and 3780 students.

**check the semester roster in the Art Office to verify when classes are scheduled.*
